

DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY FOR PACKAGING

Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR), Article 5(4) and Article 5(5)

Sauro s.r.l. hereby declares that the materials used to manufacture the packaging that protects the products supplied to its customers comply with the provisions of Regulation 2025/40 (PPWR), Article 5(4).

Based on the declarations issued by our raw material suppliers, the technical documentation in our possession and our production process, heavy metals such as lead, cadmium, mercury and chromium (VI) are not used in the manufacture of the packaging. However, we cannot rule out the possibility that traces of these metals may be present at levels in the order of ppm (parts per million), though in any case below the limits set by the PPWR Regulation.

We would also like to point out that the provisions of Article 5(5) regarding PFAS content do not apply to us, as our packaging does not come into direct contact with food.

The packaging supplied is recyclable in accordance with the relevant collection schemes and the material composition as set out in the technical data sheet, where applicable.

This declaration is issued on the basis of the information available at the date of issue, the technical information and declarations received from the suppliers of the raw materials, semi-finished products and packaging supplied.

The information is based on our current knowledge. In view of the numerous factors that may influence processing and application, these data do not exempt processors from carrying out their own tests and trials. Nor do they imply any legally binding guarantee of specific properties or suitability for a particular purpose.

While awaiting the future delegated acts, implementing acts and guidance on application provided for under the PPWR framework leading up to 2030, Sauro will continue to:

- 1) collect technical documentation from its suppliers;
- 2) assess packaging types against the applicable requirements;
- 3) support customers in choosing suitable solutions;
- 4) propose, where available, alternatives containing recycled material or offering improved sustainability;
- 5) keep customers updated on relevant regulatory developments.

At the same time, Sauro is evaluating alternative solutions and more sustainable materials in collaboration with its manufacturing partners, including options containing post-consumer recycled



content, where technically compatible with the requirements of the process, automation and the protection of electronic components.

Should a customer require customised packaging, it is important to emphasise that the final compliance of a material or packaging may depend on various factors; for this reason, we invite customers to assess the requirements regarding shape, compatibility and function of the materials within their own applications and, where necessary, within the applications of their end customers.

Sauro remains available to provide the necessary documentation, support technical assessments and share updates regarding developments in the PPWR framework
